## DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT NATURAL PARENTS

### Disclosure of medical information about natural parents

- 11.—(1) Where an adoption agency has not been able to obtain the information specified in paragraph 13 of Part III of schedule 1 to the 2009 Regulations(1), (whether there is any history of genetically transmissible or other significant disease in the family history of either the father's or mother's family) a registered medical practitioner holding any such information must disclose it to the adoption agency when requested to do so.
- (2) Any information disclosed to an adoption agency under this regulation must be placed on the case record relating to an adopted child.
- (3) Any information disclosed to an adoption agency under this regulation must be treated by that agency as confidential.
