**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A68 Trunk Road (Lauder) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2009

<i>Made</i>	<i>22<sup>nd</sup> September 2009</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>5<sup>th</sup> October 2009</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A68 Trunk Road (Lauder) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and comes into force on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2009.

**Restriction of speed**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## Revocation of previous Orders

3. (1) Paragraph 3 of the Schedule to the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Berwickshire) Order 1975<sup>(a)</sup> is revoked.

(2) The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Berwickshire) (Variation) Order 1996<sup>(b)</sup> is revoked.
