ROAD TRAFFIC

The A77 Trunk Road (Dalrymple Street, Girvan) (Special Event)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>4th December 2009</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with Section 16A(2) of that Act they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the switching on of Christmas lights, enabling members of the public to watch this event and other associated social events and entertainment.

In accordance with Section 16A(3) of that Act they are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for such an event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with Section 16A(8) of that Act they have had regard to the safety and convenience of an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Dalrymple Street, Girvan) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009, comes into force at 0:01 hours on 4th December 2009 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 4th December 2009.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to Article 3 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance, or police purposes, or a vehicle while being used in connection with the switching on of the Christmas lights and associated social events and entertainment.

That length of the southbound A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road known as Dalrymple Street, Girvan from its junction with Knockcushan Street, Girvan to its junction with Wesley Road, Girvan, a distance of 355 metres or thereby.
