**The Housing Revenue Account General Fund
Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2009**

Made - - - - *11th February 2009*
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - *12th February 2009*
Coming into force - - *19th March 2009*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 204 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2009 and comes into force on 19th March 2009.

General fund contribution limits

2. The amount of contribution out of its general fund which a local authority may estimate that it will carry to the credit of its housing revenue account for the year 2009–2010 is limited to nil.
