ROAD TRAFFIC

The M73 Trunk Road (Gartcosh to Mollinsburn) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>30 November 2009</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there are alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M73 Trunk Road (Gartcosh to Mollinsburn) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009, comes into force on 30 November 2009 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 30 May 2011.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to article 3 of this Order no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said lengths of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the M73 Maryville - Mollinsburn Trunk Road being the northbound off slip road at the A80-Westfield Link Road, a distance of 255 metres or thereby.
2. That length of the M73 Maryville-Mollinsburn Trunk Road being the northbound off slip road at the A80, a distance of 634 metres or thereby.
