Form of Notice of Summons — breach of inhibition

Notice of Summons in an Action of Reduction of conveyance or deed in breach of an Inhibition

To: The Keeper of the Registers of Scotland

If the property is held on a title recorded in the General Register of Sasines, a description in conformity with Schedule D or J to the Conveyancing (Scotland) Act 1924 may be used. If the property is registered in the Land Register of Scotland, the title number should be inserted.

As soon as reasonably practicable (and if possible on the same day) after the Summons is signeted this Notice must be registered in the Register of Inhibitions and Adjudications and a copy registered in the [*Land Register of Scotland] [*the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of *(County)*].
