**The European Communities (European Order
for Payment) (Scotland) Regulations 2009**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations, for the purpose of restricting to the sheriff courts only the effect of Regulation (EC) No. 1896/2006 of 12th December 2006⁽¹⁾ creating a European order for payment procedure, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽²⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.
