The Additional Support for Learning (Appropriate Agencies) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 23(2) (c) of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2004⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Additional Support for Learning (Appropriate Agencies) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16th August 2010.

Amendment of paragraph 2 of the Additional Support for Learning (Appropriate Agencies) (Scotland) Order 2005

2. For paragraph 2(c) of the Additional Support for Learning (Appropriate Agencies) (Scotland) Order 2005⁽²⁾ (appropriate agencies) substitute—

“(c) The Skills Development Scotland Co. Limited”.
