**The Advice and Assistance and Civil Legal Aid (Transfer of Tribunal Functions) (No. 1) (Scotland) Regulations 2010**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12(3), 17(2B), 33(2)(a) and (3) and 36(1), (2)(a), (c), (g) and (h) and (3)(e) of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.
