**The Arbitration (Scotland) Act 2010 (Commencement  
No. 1 and Transitional Provisions) Order 2010**

**Transitional provisions**

5.—(1) Where an enactment provides for the date upon which arbitration begins for the purposes of that enactment, section 4(4)(b) of the Prescription and Limitation (Scotland) Act 1973<sup>(1)</sup> is to be read as if the reference to rule 1 of the Scottish Arbitration Rules is a reference to when arbitration begins under that enactment.

(2) This article ceases to have effect on date on which the Act is commenced for the purposes of statutory arbitration.
