ROAD TRAFFIC

The A85 Trunk Road (Connel) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2010

<i>Coming into force</i>	<i>31st May 2010</i>

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(**b**).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (Connel) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2010 and comes into force on 31st May 2010.

Restriction of speed

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

That length of the A85 Tyndrum to Oban Trunk Road from a point opposite the extended northeastern gable of the property known as Scotholm, Connel eastwards to a point 58 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of the access to the property known as Dunfuinary, Connel a distance of 475 metres or thereby.
