# The Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2010

Made - - - - 9th June 2010
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - 11th June 2010
Coming into force - 5th July 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of, and paragraph 1A of Schedule 2 to, the European Communities Act 1972(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

These Regulations make provision for a purpose mentioned in section 2(2) of that Act and it appears to the Scottish Ministers that it is expedient for the references to the legislation set out in Schedule 1 to the Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Regulations 2007(2) to be construed as references to those instruments as amended from time to time.

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2010 and come into force on 5th July 2010.

# Amendment to the Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Regulations 2007

- **2.**—(1) The Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Regulations 2007 are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 24(2) (consignments and products illegally brought in) for "paragraph (4)" in the first place that term occurs substitute "paragraph (5)".
- (3) For Schedule 1 (import conditions) substitute the Schedule 1 set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations substitute a new Schedule 1 to the Products of Animal Origin (Third Country Imports) (Scotland) Regulations 2007 ("the principal Regulations") and correct a minor error in regulation 24 of those Regulations.

Schedule 1 (import conditions) to the principal Regulations as inserted by these Regulations is a rolling consolidation of that Schedule, listing both the legislation in that Schedule when the principal Regulations were made and relevant legislation that has come into force since then. The new Schedule provides updated references to the EU instruments that set out the requirements to be enforced under the Principal Regulations when the products of animal origin in question are imported from third (non-EU) countries.

The references to EU instruments contained within the new Schedule are to be construed as references to the text of those instruments as amended from time to time. 'As amended' versions of the EU instruments can be found on the Eur Lex website (http://eur-lex.europa.eu/en/index.htm).
