ROAD TRAFFIC

The A725/A726 Trunk Road (Peel Park) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made 11th June 2010

Coming into force 19th June 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with Section 14(1)(a) of that Act they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with Section 14(3) of that Act of that Act they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A725/A726 Trunk Road (Peel Park) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010, comes into force at 0600 hours on 19th June 2010 and ceases to have effect at 1800 hours on 20th June 2010.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to articles 3 and 4 no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Permission or direction of Police Constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

4. This Order does not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

Article 2

That length of the A725/A726 Shawhead – East Kilbride – Phillipshill Roundabout Trunk Road being the westbound carriageway from West Mains Roundabout to Phillipshill Roundabout a distance of 1.3 kilometres or thereby.
