ROAD TRAFFIC

The M8/A8 Trunk Road (Secondary Carriageway, Junction 21, Paisley Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made

14th July 2010

Coming into force

1st August 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M8/A8 Trunk Road (Secondary Carriageway, Junction 21, Paisley Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010, comes into force on 1st August 2010 and ceases to have an effect at midnight on 30th August 2010.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to article 3 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length road by means of traffic signs as prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemptions for works vehicles

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound secondary carriageway from Junction 21, Seaward Street to Junction 21, Paisley Road (Paisley Road off ramp), a distance of 500 metres or thereby.
