**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A96 Trunk Road (Cawdor Castle Concert)  
(Temporary Restriction of Speed) Order 2010**

*Made*

*13th August 2010*

*Coming into force*

*27th August 2010*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1), (4), 2(1) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Cawdor Castle Concert) (Temporary Restriction of Speed) Order 2010, comes into force at 1200 hours on 27th August 2010 and ceases to have effect at 0600 hours on 29th August 2010.

## **Temporary speed restriction**

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 mph when that restriction is identified as applying to any part or parts of the length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a).

That length of the A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 1 kilometre or thereby west of the junction with the B9006 Ardersier Road at Brackley eastwards to a point 1 kilometre or thereby east of the junction with the B9006 Ardersier Road at Brackley, a distance of 2 kilometres or thereby.
