**The Contaminants in Food (Scotland) Regulations 2010**

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) In these Regulations—

“the Act” means the Food Safety Act 1990;

“Commission Regulation 1881/2006” means [Commission Regulation \(EC\) No. 1881/2006](#) setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuffs<sup>(1)</sup>;

“Commission Regulation 629/2008” means [Commission Regulation \(EC\) No. 629/2008](#) amending Regulation [\(EC\) No. 1881/2006](#) setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuffs<sup>(2)</sup>;

“Commission Regulation 124/2009” means [Commission Regulation \(EC\) No. 124/2009](#) setting maximum levels for the presence of coccidiostats or histomonostats in food resulting from the unavoidable carry-over of these substances in non-target feed<sup>(3)</sup>;

“Commission Regulation 165/2010” means [Commission Regulation \(EU\) No. 165/2010](#) amending Regulation [\(EC\) No. 1881/2006](#) setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuffs as regards aflatoxins<sup>(4)</sup>.

(2) Any other expression used in these Regulations and in [Commission Regulation 1881/2006](#) or in [Commission Regulation 124/2009](#) has the same meaning in these Regulations as it bears in the [Commission Regulation](#) concerned.

(3) Any reference to “the Annex” is a reference to the Annex to [Commission Regulation 1881/2006](#) as that Annex may be amended from time to time, and any reference to that Regulation is to be construed accordingly.
