The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9(6), 17CA(1), (5), (6) and (7), 17E, 28(1), 105(7), 106(a) and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Section 108(1) defines “prescribed” and “regulations” relevant to the exercise of the statutory powers under which these Regulations are made. The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
