**The Town and Country Planning (Modification and Discharge of Planning Obligations) (Scotland) Regulations 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *2nd December 2010*  
*Laid before the Scottish*  
*Parliament* - - - - - *6th December 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - *1st February 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 43, 75A, 75B, 267, 275 and 275A of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.
