- **2.**—(1) The Schedule to the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 (Consequential Provisions) Order 2011(2) is amended as follows.
 - (2) In paragraph 3, for sub-paragraph (4) substitute—
 - "(4) In paragraph (b) of regulation 12 (application of regulations) for "which now holds" to the end, substitute "which operates from premises in respect of which there is a premises licence in terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005"."
 - (3) In paragraph 4, for sub-paragraph (2)(a) substitute—
 - "(a) after the definition of "the Act" insert ""the 2005 Act" means the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005";".
