

EXECUTIVE NOTE

THE LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 (CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS) AMENDMENT ORDER 2011

SSI 2011/187

The above instrument is made in exercise of the powers conferred on Scottish Ministers by sections 145 and 146(2) and (3) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Policy objectives

The order is technical in nature and corrects two errors in the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 (Consequential Provisions) Order 2011⁽²⁾.

Regulatory Impact

The order has no impact for business. It simply ensures the amendments to subordinate legislation which are being made by the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 (Consequential Provisions) Order 2011 are framed clearly.

Financial Effects

The instrument is not expected to have any significant financial effects on Scottish Government, local government or on business. Therefore, there is no requirement for a Business and Regulatory Impact Assessment to be undertaken.
