The Lord President makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12(1) of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 1937(1) and all other powers enabling him to do so.

In accordance with section 12(2) of that Act, section 6(2) of the Statutory Instruments Act 1946(2), and articles 3(3) and 12 of the Scotland Act 1998 (Transitory and Transitional Provisions) (Statutory Instruments) Order 1999(3), a draft of the Regulations has been laid before the Scotlish Parliament and a period of 40 days has expired without the Parliament passing a resolution that the Regulations be not made.
