The Scottish Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 43(1) and (2)(a) of the Wildlife and Natural Environment (Scotland) Act 2011<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife and Natural Environment (Scotland) Act 2011 (Commencement No. 1) Amendment Order 2011 and comes into force on 29th June 2011.

**Amendment of Commencement No. 1 Order**

2.—(1) The Wildlife and Natural Environment (Scotland) Act 2011 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2011<sup>(2)</sup> is amended as follows.

(2) For article 2(1)(i)(ii) substitute—

“(ii) the first to the thirteenth, the fifteenth to the eighteenth, and the last entry of Part 2 of the schedule;”.

This Order corrects an error in the Wildlife and Natural Environment (Scotland) Act 2011 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2011 ([S.S.I. 2011/279](#)).

The effect is that the Finance Act 1924 and the Game Act 1970 are repealed, and the Destructive Imported Animals Act 1932 is not repealed.
