The Property Factors (Registration) (Scotland) Regulations 2012

Information to be specified in an application for registration as a property factor

3. An application for registration under section 3(1) of the Act must also specify—
- (a) any conviction of a relevant person relating to any offence involving a matter mentioned in section 5(2)(a) of the Act;
 - (b) any court or tribunal judgment against a relevant person under the Equality Act 2010⁽¹⁾ or any of—
 - (i) the Equal Pay Act 1970⁽²⁾;
 - (ii) the Sex Discrimination Act 1975⁽³⁾;
 - (iii) the Race Relations Act 1976⁽⁴⁾;
 - (iv) the Disability Discrimination Act 1995⁽⁵⁾;
 - (v) the Employment Equality (Sexual Orientation) Regulations 2003⁽⁶⁾;
 - (vi) the Employment Equality (Religion or Belief) Regulations 2003⁽⁷⁾; and
 - (c) in relation to a contravention by a relevant person of a provision mentioned in section 5(2) of the Act—
 - (i) any conviction of an offence; or
 - (ii) any finding of a court or tribunal.
