# TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING

The Town and Country Planning (Continuation in force of South Lanarkshire Local Plan) (Scotland) Order 2012

Made - - - 12th June 2012
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - 14th June 2012
Coming into force - - 29th June 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 7 of Schedule 1 to the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to that Act they have consulted South Lanarkshire Council.

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Continuation in force of South Lanarkshire Local Plan) (Scotland) Order 2012 and comes into force on 29th June 2012.

#### Continuation in force of local plan

**2.** The Scottish Ministers direct that, notwithstanding the adoption of the South Lanarkshire Minerals Local Development Plan(2), the whole provisions of the South Lanarkshire Local Plan(3) shall continue in force to full effect in relation to the area to which the South Lanarkshire Minerals Local Development Plan relates.
