The Criminal Legal Aid (Scotland) (Fees) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 33(2)(a) and (3)(a) and 36(1) of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Legal Aid (Scotland) (Fees) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 18th December 2012.

(2) These Regulations apply only to fees for work done and outlays incurred on or after 18th December 2012.

Amendment to the Criminal Legal Aid (Scotland) (Fees) Regulations 1989

2. In regulation 3A(g) of the Criminal Legal Aid (Scotland) (Fees) Regulations 1989(2), for “1998” substitute “1988”.
