**The Town and Country Planning (Continuation in force  
of Local Plans) (Highland) (Scotland) Order 2012**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 7 of Schedule 1 to the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to that Act they have consulted the Highland Council.
