

## SCHEDULE 1

### MODIFICATIONS RELATING TO POLICE

#### PART 1

##### Modification of Acts

###### *Housing (Scotland) Act 1987*

**10.**—(1) The Housing (Scotland) Act 1987<sup>(1)</sup> is modified as follows.

(2) In section 69A(1)(a) (power to refuse to sell houses required for police purposes)<sup>(2)</sup>, for the first “a” to “(c.77)” substitute “the Scottish Police Authority as landlord in relation to a house which it holds for the purposes of maintaining the Police Service of Scotland”.

(3) In section 82 (interpretation of Part III)<sup>(3)</sup>, in the definition of “police authority”, for the first “a” to “section 19” substitute “the Scottish Police Authority established by section 1 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (asp 8)”.
