The Plant Health (Scotland) Amendment Order 2013

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2, 3 and 4(1) of the Plant Health Act 1967(1), section 20 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972(2) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

makes provision which Scottish Ministers expedient spread Scotland, preventing the introduction and pests in particular Clavibacter michiganensisssp. sepedonicus (Spieckerman and Kotthoff) Daviset al. and Epitrix cucumeris (Harris), Epitrix similaris (Gentner), Epitrix subcrinita (Lec.) and Epitrix tuberis(Gentner).
