**The Parking Attendants (Wearing of Uniforms)
(Fife Council Parking Area) Regulations 2013**

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Parking Attendants (Wearing of Uniforms) (Fife Council Parking Area) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 29th April 2013.

(2) In these Regulations—

“the 1984 Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“the 1991 Act” means the Road Traffic Act 1991(1); and

“Fife council parking area” means the area designated as a permitted parking area and a special parking area by article 3 of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Fife Council) Designation Order 2013.

Prescribed functions

2.—(1) All functions conferred on parking attendants by or under the enactments mentioned in paragraph (2) are prescribed for the purposes of section 63A(4) of the 1984 Act (wearing of uniforms by parking attendants when exercising prescribed functions) in its application to the Fife council parking area.

(2) The enactments referred to in paragraph (1) are—

(a) section 99 of the 1984 Act (removal of vehicles);

(b) section 66(1) of the 1991 Act (issue of a penalty charge notice); and

(c) section 69 of the 1991 Act (immobilisation of vehicles).
