The A85 Trunk Road (Stafford Street, Oban) (Detrunking) Order 2014

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(**a**), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 5(2) of that Act, they have taken into consideration the requirements of local and national planning, including the requirements of agriculture and industry and are satisfied as to expediency.

This Order is made in accordance with the provisions of Parts I and III of Schedule $1(\mathbf{b})$ to that Act.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (Stafford Street, Oban) (Detrunking) Order 2014, and comes into force on 10th February 2014.

Road Ceasing to be Trunk Road

2. On the date this Order comes into force the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be trunk road and Argyll and Bute Council(a) shall become the roads authority for those lengths of road and shall enter those lengths of road in their list of public roads(**b**).

SCHEDULE

Interpretation

1. In this Schedule—

"the A85 Trunk Road" means the A85 Tyndrum - Oban Trunk Road;

"the plan" means the plan numbered 01/NW/001 entitled "the A85 Trunk Road (Stafford Street, Oban) (Detrunking) Order 2014", signed with reference to this Order and deposited at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF.

Lengths Of Road Ceasing To Be Trunk Road

2. Those lengths of the A85 Trunk Road, from the intersection point of the extended south kerbline of Corran Esplanade, Oban and the extended east kerbline of Stafford Street, Oban, eastwards to the intersection of the extended north kerbline of George Street and the extended east kerbline of Stafford Street, Oban a distance of 47 metres or thereby, as shown by black and white hatching between points A and B on the plan.
