ROADS AND BRIDGES

**The Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Amendment
Regulations 2014**

Made - - - - - *26th February 2014*

Laid before the Scottish Parliament *28th February 2014*

Coming into force - - - *1st April 2014*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 134 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 163A of that Act(b) they have consulted with such—

- (a) persons considered by them to be representative of the interests of undertakers;
- (b) road works authorities; and
- (c) other persons,

as they think appropriate.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2014 and come into force on 1st April 2014.

Amendment of the Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2003

2. In regulation 3(1) (inspection fees) of the Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2003(c) for “£33.00” substitute “£36.00”.

(a) 1991 c.22; see section 163(1) of that Act for a definition of “prescribed”. The functions of the Secretary of State, so far as they were exercisable within devolved competence, were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

3. The Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2012(a) are revoked.
