THE CONTINUING CARE (SCOTLAND) ORDER 2015

SCHEDULE Matters to be considered in the welfare assessment

- 4. The eligible person's schooling, skills and experience, qualifications and certificates,...
- 5. The eligible person's future plans for study, training or work....
- 6. The eligible person's current accommodation arrangements, practical living skills, accommodation...
- 7. The eligible person's sources of income, outgoings, savings and debts,...
