ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Laggan Swing Bridge) (Temporary Width Restriction) Order 2015

Made - - - - 7th January 2015

Coming into force - - 12th January 2015

The Scottish Ministers, make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

In accordance with section 14(1A) of that Act, they have consulted with the affected National Park(\mathbf{b}).

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Laggan Swing Bridge) (Temporary Width Restriction) Order 2015, comes into force on 12th January 2015 and ceases to have effect on 20th March 2015.

Temporary restriction of use of vehicles

2. Subject to article 3 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule if the width of the vehicle exceeds 3 metres, when such restriction is identified as applying to any part or parts of the that length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by Diagram 629A of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**c**).

Exemption

- 3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—
 - (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or
 - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

Article 2

That length of the A82 Dalnotter – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 10 metres or thereby south of its junction with the U1223 Invergarry Station Road, northwards to a point 14 metres or thereby south of its junction with the U1035 Kilfinnan Road, a distance of 411 metres or thereby.
