**The Animal By-Products (Miscellaneous Amendments) (Scotland) Regulations 2015**

**Amendment of the Transport of Animals (Cleansing and Disinfection) (Scotland) Regulations 2005**

**3.** For regulation 5(2) of the Transport of Animals (Cleansing and Disinfection) (Scotland) Regulations 2005 (disposal of material after cleansing)(**1**), substitute—

“(2) This regulation shall not apply to any material required to be disposed of in accordance with—

- (a) Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (Animal by-products Regulation)(**2**);
- (b) Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 implementing Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and implementing Council Directive 97/78/EC as regards certain samples and items exempt from veterinary checks at the border under that Directive(**3**); and
- (c) the Animal By-Products (Enforcement) (Scotland) Regulations 2013.”.
