Approval

The above named club is approved under section 18(1) of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015. Any member of the club may, without holding an air weapon certificate, use or possess an air weapon if engaged as such a member in target shooting at the club, another approved air weapon club, an event or competition, or in connection with such target shooting.

Conditions

This approval is subject to the following conditions –

1. The above named Club Secretary / Officer must, on receipt of the approval, sign it in ink.
2. The club must, as soon as reasonably practicable, notify the Chief Constable of the Police Service of Scotland of any change of the club's address.
3. This approval (or a copy of it) must be prominently displayed at the club premises, at all times that target shooting is taking place there, so as to be capable of being read by anyone using the club's facilities.

Additional conditions may be added here by the Chief Constable of the Police Service of Scotland

Note

It is an offence under section 30 of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015 for a person to fail to take reasonable precautions for the safe custody of an air weapon possessed by the person, or to fail to report as soon as reasonably practicable to the Chief Constable of the Police Service of Scotland the loss or theft of an air weapon possessed by the person.
