ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A78 Trunk Road (Largs) (Temporary Prohibition on
Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2016**

Made - - - - *8th August 2016*

Coming into force - - *14th August 2016*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Largs) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2016, comes into force on 14th August 2016 and ceases to have effect on 15th August 2016.

Prohibition on waiting, loading and unloading

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the schedule of this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of the traffic sign described in item 22 of the sign table in Part 6 of schedule 13 (diagram 640.1) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road known as Main Street, Largs from a point 25 metres of thereby southeast of the point where it meets the extended southeast kerb line of Bath Street to the point where it meets the extended southeast kerb line of Gogo Street, a distance of 354 metres or thereby.
