# The Scottish Tribunals (Eligibility for Appointment) Amendment Regulations 2017

Made - - - - 30th August 2017
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - 1st September 2017
Coming into force - 2nd October 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 80 and paragraph 1(2) of schedule 3 of the Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Scottish Tribunals (Eligibility for Appointment) Amendment Regulations 2017 and come into force on 2nd October 2017.
- (2) In these Regulations, "the 2015 Regulations" means the Scottish Tribunals (Eligibility for Appointment) Regulations 2015(2).

#### Amendment of the 2015 Regulations

- 2.—(1) The 2015 Regulations are amended in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) After regulation 3, insert—

## "Eligibility for appointment as an ordinary member of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (health and education experience)

- **3A.** A person is eligible for appointment as an ordinary member of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland if the person has knowledge and experience of children or young persons with—
  - (a) additional support needs within the meaning of section 1(1) of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2004(3); or

(b) a disability within the meaning of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010(4).

# Eligibility for appointment as an ordinary member of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (charity regulatory experience)

**3B.** A person is eligible for appointment as an ordinary member of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland if the person has knowledge and experience in accounting or governance of public or private bodies or charities.".
