CONSERVATION OF SEA FISH

The Shellfish (Restrictions on Taking by Unlicensed Fishing Boats) (Scotland) Order 2017

Made	28th February 2017
Laid before the Scottish Parliament	2nd March 2017
Coming into force	17th April 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1) (b) and (2) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.
