**The Plant Health (Miscellaneous  
Amendments) (Scotland) Order 2019**

**Amendment of the Plant Health (Scotland) Order 2005**

- 2.—(1) The Plant Health (Scotland) Order 2005<sup>(1)</sup> is amended as follows.
- (2) In article 21, omit paragraph (8).
- (3) In the table in Part C of schedule 4, after item 10 insert—

|  | <p>(a) been grown throughout their life in places of production in countries in which <i>Thaumetopoea processionea</i> L. is not known to occur;</p> <p>(b) been grown throughout their life in a protected zone which is recognised as a protected zone for <i>Thaumetopoea processionea</i> L. or in an area free from <i>Thaumetopoea processionea</i> L., established by the national plant protection organisation in accordance with IPSM No. 4; or</p> <p>(c) been grown throughout their life in a site with complete physical protection against the introduction of <i>Thaumetopoea processionea</i> L. and have been inspected at appropriate times and found to be free from <i>Thaumetopoea processionea</i> L.”</p> |
