The Marketing of Fruit Plant and Propagating Material (Scotland) Regulations 2017

- **8.**—(1) The Marketing of Fruit Plant and Propagating Material (Scotland) Regulations 2017 M1 are amended as follows.
 - (2) In regulation 2(1) (interpretation)—
 - (a) at the end of the definition of "plant variety rights", insert " or domestic legislation in countries or territories, other than those forming part of the United Kingdom, that affords plant variety protection in accordance with UPOV",
 - (b) after the definition of "supplier's document" insert— ""UPOV" means the International Union for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants, being an intergovernmental organisation established by the International Convention for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants ^{M2};".
- (3) In schedule 4 (registration of varieties), in paragraph 1 (interpretation), omit the definition of "UPOV".
