The Court of Session makes this Act of Sederunt under the powers conferred by sections 66 and 67 of the Counter-Terrorism Act 2008(a), section 103(1) of the Courts Reform (Scotland) Act 2014(b) and all other powers enabling it to do so.

Citation and commencement, etc.

- **1.**—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of the Court of Session 1994 Amendment) (Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering) (No.2) 2019.
 - (2) It comes into force on 29th March 2019.
 - (3) A certified copy is to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

2.—(1) The Act of Sederunt (Rules of the Court of Session 1994 Amendment) (Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering) 2019(**c**) is amended in accordance with this paragraph.
