#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Planning (Scotland) Act 2019 (Commencement No. 6 and Transitional Provision) Amendment Regulations 2021 and come into force on 29 September 2021.

- **2.**—(1) The Planning (Scotland) Act 2019 (Commencement No. 6 and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2021(**b**) are amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).
- (2) In regulation 3 (appointed day pre-application consultation) for "1 October 2021" substitute "1 April 2022".
  - (3) In regulation 4 (transitional provision)—
    - (a) in paragraph (1) for "1 October 2021" substitute "1 April 2022", and
    - (b) in paragraph (2) for "1 October 2021" substitute "1 April 2022".

These Regulations amend the Planning (Scotland) Act 2019 (Commencement No. 6 and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2021. The changes made by regulation 2(2) amend those Regulations to bring section 18(3) of the Planning (Scotland) Act 2019 ("the Act") into force on 1 April 2022 rather than 1 October 2021. Regulation 2(3) makes consequential changes to the transitional provision contained in regulation 4 of those Regulations.
