3 Interpretation.

In this Measure, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“consecrated” means consecrated for the purpose of public worship according to the rites and ceremonies of the Church of England;

“parsonage house” and “pastoral scheme” have the same meanings as in the ^{M1}Pastoral Measure 1968;

“sharing agreement” and “church building” have the same meanings as in the ^{M2}Sharing of Church Buildings Act 1969, and references to the ownership of church buildings shall be construed in the same manner as in that Act.
