



# Clergy Discipline Measure 2003

## *Introductory*

### **4 President of tribunals**

- (1) The chairman and deputy chairman of the Commission shall be the president of tribunals and the deputy president respectively for the purposes of this Measure.
- (2) The president of tribunals shall exercise the functions conferred on him by this Measure and in addition shall have the following duties—
  - (a) to issue practice directions;
  - (b) to act as the chairman of a disciplinary tribunal where, in his opinion, important points of law or principle are involved;
  - (c) to exercise such other functions as may be prescribed.
- (3) [<sup>F1</sup>Subject to subsection (4) below,] The deputy president of tribunals shall act for the president when the president is absent or is unable or unwilling to act.
- [<sup>F2</sup>(4) The president or deputy president of tribunals may select any person who may be appointed as the chairman of a disciplinary tribunal under section 22(1) below to act in his place when he is absent or unable or unwilling to act.]
