Documents required from transgendered applicants

- **24.** In the case of an applicant who lives in two gender roles and is applying for details of both genders to be entered in the Register, a report from a registered medical practitioner or a chartered psychologist practicing in the field of gender dysphoria that the individual has a need to live at least part of their life in a gender other that recorded on the current birth certificate.
- **25.** In the case of applicant who has only provided information relating to an acquired gender, and that acquired gender is not recorded in the valid passport, valid identity card or a birth or adoption certificate in a form which contains details of the parents or, as the case may be, adoptive parents that accompanies the application:
 - (i) a gender recognition certificate, or
 - (ii) a report from a registered medical practitioner or a chartered psychologist practicing in the field of gender dysphoria that the individual has a need to has a need to live at least part of their life in a gender other than their gender recorded on their current birth certificate.
