POLICE, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 (Codes of Practice) (Revision of Codes A, B and D) Order 2010

Made - - - -

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(1)

The Secretary of State:

(1) has, in pursuance of section 66(1) of the Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984⁽¹⁾, issued codes of practice in connection with the:

- (a) exercise by police officers of statutory powers of stop and search;
- (b) searching of premises by police officers and the seizure of property found by police officers on persons or premises;
- (c) detention, treatment and questioning of persons by police officers; and
- (d) identification of persons by police officers;

(2) may, under section 67(2)⁽²⁾ of that Act, revise the whole or any part of a code;

(3) has consulted in accordance with section 67(4) of that Act; and

(4) has, in accordance with section 67(7B) of that Act, laid each revised code of practice before Parliament;

A draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament and has been approved by each House of Parliament in accordance with section 67(7A) of that Act;

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred upon her by section 67(5) of that Act, makes the following Order:
