Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 (Amendment of List of Responders) Order 2011 and comes into force on the day after the day it is made.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Civil Contingencies Act 2004

2. In Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 (category 1 responders: general) after paragraph 1 insert—

“1A. The Greater London Authority.”.
