



CHAPTER lxiv.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Government Board for Ireland relating to the Rural Districts of Rathdrum and Balrothery and the Urban District of Warrenpoint. A.D. 1910.
[26th July 1910.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Local Government Board") have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the Public Health (Ireland) Acts 1878 to 1907:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament and that the provisions herein contained should be enacted with reference to those Orders:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders as amended and set out in the schedule hereto are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in schedule confirmed.

2. The council of the urban district of Warrenpoint shall not under the powers of the Order relating to that district and hereby confirmed purchase or acquire in any urban district any house or houses which on the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either wholly or partially by thirty or more persons belonging to the working class as tenants or lodgers or except with the consent of the Local Government Board any house or houses which were not so occupied on the said fifteenth day of December but have been or shall be subsequently so occupied. Restriction of power to take houses of working class.

If the said council acquire or appropriate any house or houses for the purposes of that Order in contravention of the foregoing provisions they shall be liable to a penalty of five hundred pounds in respect of every such house which penalty shall be recoverable by the Local Government Board by action in the High Court and shall be carried to and form part of the Consolidated Fund of the United Kingdom Provided that the Court may if it think fit reduce such penalty.

For the purposes of this section the expression "house" means any house or part of a house occupied as a separate dwelling and the expression "working class" means mechanics artizans labourers and others working for wages hawkers costermongers persons not working for wages but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others except members of their own families and persons other than domestic servants whose income does not exceed an average of thirty shillings a week and the families of any of such persons who may be residing with them.

Increase of borrowing powers by urban district council of Warrenpoint under 41 & 42 Vict. c. 52.

3. The amount which the urban district council of Warrenpoint may borrow under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 for the purposes of the Warrenpoint Order 1910 hereby confirmed and of carrying out the scheme for which the lands water and rights mentioned in that Order are required shall be increased by a sum not exceeding five thousand pounds and any sum borrowed by that council for the purposes of said Order and of carrying out said scheme save in so far as and to the amount that such sum exceeds five thousand pounds shall not be reckoned in calculating the amount which they may borrow under the said Act for purposes other than the purposes of the said Order.

Short title.

4. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 3) Act 1910.

RURAL DISTRICT OF RATHDRUM.

Provisional Order to enable the Council of the Rural District of Rathdrum to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts. Rathdrum.

WHEREAS the council of the rural district of Rathdrum (in this Order referred to as "the district council") require to purchase and take the lands and premises described in the schedule hereto for the purpose of providing sewage disposal works for Kilpedder in their district:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board for Ireland in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 203 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect namely:—

1. The district council shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands and premises described in the schedule hereto and for the purpose aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. The costs and expenses of the district council and the Local Government Board for Ireland incurred in respect of the application for preparation making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the district council and the money required for that purpose shall be supplied by the county council of Wicklow in the manner provided by the Local Government (Ireland) Act 1898 as part of the expenses of the district council.

3. This Order may be cited as the Kilpedder Sewerage Order 1910.

Provisional Order to enable the Council of the Rural District of Balrothery to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts and for the alteration and amendment of an Act confirming a Provisional Order.

WHEREAS by the Malahide Waterworks Order 1907 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1907") which was confirmed by the Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 3) Act 1907 (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1907") the council of the rural district of Balrothery (in this Order referred to as "the district council") were empowered to put in force with reference to the lands water and rights described in the schedule to the said Order the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with respect to the purchase and taking of land otherwise than by agreement for the purpose of providing a supply of water for the town of Malahide in their district:

And whereas the district council further require for the purpose aforesaid to take and purchase the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto in addition to the lands water and rights described in the schedule to the Order of 1907:

And whereas no period is prescribed by the Order of 1907 for the exercise by the district council of the powers thereby conferred for the compulsory purchase or taking of the lands water and rights described in the schedule thereto and accordingly those powers would under section 123 of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1845 as

incorporated with the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 cease after the expiration of three years from the passing of the Act of 1907 but for the provision herein-after made for the amendment of the said Act of 1907:

And whereas the district council have petitioned the Local Government Board for Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Local Government Board") for a Provisional Order amending the said Act of 1907 to the extent and in the manner herein-after set forth:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 203 and by section 214 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect:—

1. The district council shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto and for the purpose aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. The powers conferred on the district council by the last preceding Article of this Order shall be in addition to and not in substitution for the powers conferred upon them by the Order of 1907.

3. For the purposes of this Order the expression "land" in the Lands Clauses Acts shall include the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto.

4. The Act of 1907 so far as it relates to the Order of 1907 shall be amended so as to provide as follows (that is to say):—

The powers conferred upon the district council by the Order of 1907 for the compulsory purchase or taking of the lands water and rights described in the schedule to the said Order may be exercised at any time within a period of six years from the passing of the said Act of 1907 and after the expiration of that period those powers shall cease.

5. The costs and expenses of the district council and the Local Government Board incurred in respect of the application for preparation making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the district council and the money required for that purpose shall be supplied by the county council of Dublin in the manner provided by the Local Government (Ireland) Act 1898 as part of the expenses of the district council.

WHEREAS the urban district council of Warrenpoint (in this Order referred to as "the district council") require to purchase and take the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto for the purpose of improving the supply of water for their district:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board for Ireland in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 203 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect namely:—

59 & 60 Vict. c. 54. 1. The district council shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto and for the purpose aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with reference to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "land" in the Lands Clauses Acts shall include the lands water and rights described in the schedule hereto.

3. The costs and expenses of the district council and the Local Government Board for Ireland incurred in respect of the application for preparation making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the district council out of the rate applicable by that council to defray the expenses incurred by them in the execution of the Public Health (Ireland) Acts 1878 to 1907.

4. This Order may be cited as the Warrenpoint Order 1910.
