



CHAPTER xxxiv.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Barnsley Blackburn Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital District Macclesfield Swansea and Tottenham.

A.D. 1927.

[29th July 1927.]

WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders as amended and set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force.

BOROUGH OF BARNLSLEY.

*Provisional Order for amending the Barnsley Corporation
Act 1914.*

WHEREAS the Borough of Barnsley (hereinafter referred to as "the Borough") is an Urban Sanitary District of which the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses acting by the Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") are the local authority within the meaning of the Public Health Act 1875 and there are in force in the Borough the unrepealed provisions of the Barnsley Corporation Act 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1914");

And whereas by Section 43 of the Act of 1914 the Corporation were authorised to use certain lands therein described and thereon to erect and equip a town hall and other municipal buildings;

And whereas by Section 24 of the Act of 1914 the Corporation were empowered to borrow the sums therein mentioned for the purposes of the said Section 43;

And whereas the Corporation have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order to alter and amend the Act of 1914 in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order Sections 24 and 43 of the Act of 1914 shall be altered so that the following provisions shall take effect that is to say:—

Definition.

1. In this Order "the deposited plan" means the plan which was deposited in the Office of the Minister of Health on the Sixteenth day of November One thousand nine hundred and twenty-six and of which duplicates were on the same day deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Parliaments House of Lords and in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons.

2. Section 43 of the Act of 1914 shall have effect as if for the lands referred to in that section on which the Corporation are authorised to erect a town hall and other buildings there

were therein substituted a reference to the lands coloured pink on the deposited plan.

3.—(1) In addition to the borrowing powers conferred by Section 24 of the Act of 1914 the Corporation may with the consent of the Minister of Health borrow such further moneys as may be necessary for the purposes of Section 43 of the Act of 1914.

(2) The provisions of the Act of 1914 shall apply with reference to moneys borrowed under this Order in the same manner as they apply with reference to moneys borrowed under subsection (2) of Section 24 of the Act of 1914.

4. This Order may be cited as the Barnsley Order 1927.

BOROUGH OF BLACKBURN.

Provisional Order to enable the Blackburn Corporation to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

WHEREAS the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Blackburn (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") acting by the Council as the local authority for that Borough for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of the construction of a cemetery for the said Borough :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other Statutes in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say :—

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule hereto (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking

ISLE OF THANET JOINT HOSPITAL
DISTRICT.

Provisional Order for altering certain Provisional Orders. *Isle of Thanet Order.*

WHEREAS by virtue of the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Orders 1893 to 1924 being Provisional Orders duly confirmed by Parliament the Boroughs of Margate and Ramsgate the Urban District of Broadstairs and Saint Peter's and the Rural District of the Isle of Thanet constitute a United District called the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital District of which the governing body is the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Joint Board");

And whereas the Joint Board consists of four ex-officio members and nineteen elective members representing the Councils of the Boroughs Urban District and Rural District aforesaid;

And whereas it is expedient that one additional member be elected to represent the Urban District Council of Broadstairs and Saint Peter's:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 297 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of any other power in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the said Provisional Orders shall be altered in manner following that is to say:—

1. The number of elective members on the Joint Board shall be increased from nineteen to twenty the additional member being elected by the Urban District Council of Broadstairs and Saint Peter's. Increase in number of elective members.

2. The provisions of Article IX. of the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Order 1893 as amended by the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Order 1896 shall apply to the first election of the additional member to be elected in pursuance of this Order as if the election related to the filling of a vacancy occurring on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order. First election of additional elective member.

3. This Order may be cited as the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Order 1927 and the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Orders 1893 to 1924 and this Order may be cited together as the Isle of Thanet Joint Hospital Orders 1893 to 1927. Short title.

And whereas the Corporation propose to make new byelaws with respect to new streets and buildings the subject-matter of which will be cognate to the subject-matter of certain of the provisions of the Local Act;

And whereas the Corporation have accordingly made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order partially to repeal the Local Act in the manner hereinafter set forth :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of any other powers in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

Section 55 (Waterclosets privies and ashpits).
