## CHAPTER xci.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Guildford and the West Kent Main Sewerage District.

[4th June 1930.]

**W**HEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made certain provisional orders which need confirmation by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Orders of the Minister of Health which are set out in the schedule to this Act are hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (Guildford and West Kent Main Sewerage District) Act 1930.

*Provisional Order amending the Guildford Corporation  
Act 1926.*

WHEREAS the borough of Guildford is an urban district of which the mayor aldermen and burgesses acting by the council are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875;

And whereas the provisions of the Guildford Corporation Act 1926 are in force in the Borough and section 66 of that Act provides for the holding use management control and appropriation by the Corporation of the lands in the local Act and in this order referred to as Stoke Park;

And whereas section 19 of the local Act enables the Corporation to sell lease exchange or otherwise dispose of any lands acquired by them under that Act but that section does not extend to Stoke Park;

And whereas the Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order amending the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Guildford Order 1930 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpreta-  
tion.

2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Corporation” means the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Guildford acting by the council;

“the deposited plan” means the plan which was deposited in the office of the Minister on the eighteenth day of October nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and of which duplicates were on the preceding day deposited in the office of the Clerk of Parliaments House of Lords and the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons;

“ the local Act ” means the Guildford Corporation Act A.D. 1930.

“ the Minister ” means the Minister of Health.

3. Section 19 of the local Act shall extend to that part of Stoke Park containing fifty-four acres or thereabouts which is coloured pink on the deposited plan and for the purposes of that section the part of Stoke Park so coloured shall be deemed to be lands acquired by the Corporation under the local Act.

4. The Corporation may lay out and construct roads and sewers on any lands which they may be empowered by this order to sell lease exchange or otherwise dispose of.

5. The purposes of this order shall be deemed to be purposes of the local Act for which the Corporation with the consent of the Minister may borrow money under subsection (2) of section 157 of the local Act.

6. Any capital money received by the Corporation in respect of any sale lease or other disposal of land under this order shall be applied for any purpose including repayment of borrowed money for which capital money may be applied and which is approved by the Minister.

7. Section 207 of the local Act (which relates to inquiries by the Minister) shall apply to the giving of any consent of the Minister under this order.

WEST KENT MAIN SEWERAGE DISTRICT:

*Provisional Order for altering certain Local Acts and  
 Confirming Acts.*

WHEREAS the West Kent main sewerage district and the West Kent Main Sewerage Board were constituted by the West Kent Main Sewerage Act 1875 and the Board were authorised by the local Acts confirmation Acts and orders mentioned in the first schedule to this order to construct and maintain certain sewers and works for the purpose of the carrying away and disposal of sewage from the districts of the several districts comprised within the main sewerage district ;

And whereas by the agreements mentioned in the second schedule to this order made under sections 48 and 53 of the local Act of 1875 provision was made for the carrying away and disposal by the sewers and works of the Board of the sewage from the areas now respectively forming the urban district of Bexley and the urban district of Crayford ;

And whereas it is expedient that the councils of the urban districts of Bexley and Crayford should be constituent authorities of the Board and that the West Kent main sewerage district should be extended so as to include the areas of those districts and that for those purposes the said local Acts and orders should be amended;

And whereas by article VI of the West Kent Main Sewerage Order 1886 it is provided that for the purposes of section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 the Board shall be deemed to be a local authority and the sewerage district to be the district of a local authority within the meaning of that Act:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the West Kent Main Sewerage Order 1930 and the West Kent Main Sewerage Orders 1886 to 1926 and this order may be cited together as the West Kent Main Sewerage Orders 1886 to 1930.

(2) This order shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpreta-  
tion.

2. In this order—

“the Board” means the West Kent Main Sewerage Board;

“the Bexley Council” means the council of the urban district of Bexley;

“the Crayford Council” means the council of the urban district of Crayford;

“the Urban Districts” means the urban district of Bexley and the urban district of Crayford;

“the local Acts and orders” means the local Acts confirmation Acts and orders mentioned in the first schedule to this order;

“the local Act of 1875” means the West Kent Main Sewerage Act 1875.

3.—(1) The Bexley Council and the Crayford Council shall be constituent authorities of the Board and the Urban Districts shall form part of the West Kent Main Sewerage District and the expressions “Constituent Authority” and “Constituent Authorities” in the local Acts and orders shall be deemed to include those Councils.

(2) In section 4 of the local Act of 1875 (which relates to the constitution of the Board) the words “under the provisions of this Act” are hereby repealed.

4.—(1) The Bexley Council shall be represented upon the Board by two members to be chosen by that Council from among their members and the Crayford Council shall be represented upon the Board by one member to be chosen by that Council from among their members.

(2) The first elections of the members of the Board to represent the Bexley Council and the Crayford Council shall take place at a meeting of each Council to be held within one month after the date of the confirmation of this order or within such further time as the Minister of Health may allow and not less than three days previous notice in writing of any such meeting shall be given or sent to each member of the Council by the clerk.

(3) The additional members of the Board elected at each of the first elections shall come into office upon their election and subject to the provisions of the local Acts and orders shall hold office until their successors are elected by the Bexley Council and the Crayford Council respectively at the first meeting of the Council held after the fifteenth day of April nineteen hundred and thirty-one.

(4) The clerk to the Bexley Council and the clerk to the Crayford Council shall forthwith notify in writing to the secretary of the Board the name address and occupation of each person elected by the Council under this article.

5. For the purpose of contributions to the Board in pursuance of the local Acts and orders the Bexley Council and the Crayford Council shall be deemed to have been constituent authorities from the first day of April nineteen hundred and thirty.

6. The agreements mentioned in the second schedule to this order shall cease to have effect :

Provided that no payment under those agreements shall be made to the Board by the Bexley Council or the Crayford Council in respect of any period after the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and thirty but nothing in this order shall affect the recovery by the Board of any sum due in respect of any period before that day.

7. Notwithstanding anything in the local Acts and orders or in byelaws made thereunder it shall be lawful for the Bexley Council to discharge into the sewers of the Board the drainage of any roof within the area which constituted the Saint Mary's ward of the urban district of Bexley prior to the renaming and alteration of that ward by the order of the county council of Kent which was finally approved by that council on the fifteenth day of May nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and it shall not be unlawful for the Bexley Council to connect any sewer with a sewer of the Board solely by reason of the fact that the sewer of the Council is used or intended to be used to convey any such drainage.
